

Iskender Yilgör received his BS, MS and PhD degrees in Chemistry from Middle East Technical University, Ankara, Turkey. He was a visiting scientist at Virginia Tech (1980-1985) and later he served as VP R&D at Thoratec Labs (1985-1989) Berkeley, CA, and Goldschmidt Chemical Corp. (1989-1994) Hopewell, VA. In 1994 he joined Koç University, as the founding member of Chemistry Department, where he also established Polymer Research Laboratories, KUYTAM Surface Science and Technology Center and KU Health Sciences Institute. He received TÜBİTAK Science Award in 2003 and was a member of TÜBİTAK Science Board (2009-2013). Prof. Yilgör's research interests include synthesis and structure-morphology-property behavior of segmented polyurethanes, preparation of polymeric 3D scaffolds for tissue engineering and bulk and surface modification of polymers. He published 2 books, over 125 refereed articles and is a co-inventor on 20 US and international patents.
